

# Scholarship Information 2016

- 1) Your school has to be an ICCA member or you as an individual have to be an ICCA member to be eligible for a scholarship.
- 2) You must complete the form online by December 1<sup>st</sup> to be considered for a scholarship.
- 3) Potential scholarship winners will be interviewed on Friday, January 6<sup>th</sup> and finalists must be in attendance at the awards ceremony on Saturday, January 7<sup>th</sup> to be eligible for the scholarship.
- 4) You need to contact the registrar at your school and have him or her send an official transcript that includes a non-weighted GPA and ACT/SAT score. This should be in a sealed envelope and sent to the Scholarship Director (address on google form).
- 5) You must download the coach's questionnaire from the google form and give it to your coach to fill out and send in a sealed envelope to the Scholarship Director (address on google form)
- 6) Create your video using the directions below and post it to an online, web-based hosting site such as [www.Youtube.com](http://www.Youtube.com) and paste the link in the section on the application.

Instructions: Applicant must be in uniform. Other athletes must be in practice clothing. All skills must be performed on a cheer mat (No spring floor). No other cheerleaders should be on the video except for the stunt portion of the video. Your video must be a maximum of 2 minutes.

Your video should be in the following order:

Floor Cheer with dance incorporated in it (no stunts; dance should have three 8-counts)  
Combination Jump (Demonstrate your best triple jump)  
Tumbling (include your best standing and running pass)  
Stunt sequence (Applicants for the stunt sequence may be the base, top or back spot but not the front spot).

- 7) You must upload an individual photo (wallet size) of yourself on the application. You should be in your uniform and it should be a headshot only. The photo should be in jpeg.format. If you are a finalist, this is the photo that will be used for the program.
